Partnership Be Involved	RECOGNIZE the diversity of learning styles represented at our school and provide RIGOROUS and RELEVANT instruction that meets students' unique needs.	PARTICIPATE in decisions about your child's education through becoming a Volunteer, joining PTA, or serving on the School Advisory Council (SAC).	Be PREPARED to make academic goals, display a POSITIVE attitude that is ready for learning, and PARTICIPATE in school activities.
Communication Stay Informed	Meet the NEEDS of every student by building positive relationships with students and parents through effectively communicating academic and social objectives through the use of face to face conferences, agenda, emails, and phone calls.	TALK to your child about displaying a positive attitude, respecting others, and following School-Wide Expectations. REVIEW and RETURN all important documents in a timely manner and sign agenda daily.	TRUST that your parent, teachers, and school administrators have partnered to assure your academic success. Remember, you must take ownership of your learning as well. Stay informed of your academic and behavior progress.
